



Riparian Tree/Shrub Species Routinely Planted and Encouraged on HRWC Stream Restoration Project Sites

Mid-size shrub (4-10')

- Silky
dogwood* (*Cornus amomum*)
Wild azalea* (*Rhododendron periclymenoides*)
Buttonbush* (*Cephalanthus occidentalis* L.)
Spicebush (*Lindera benzoin*)
Elderberry (*Sambucus canadensis*)

Large shrub (over 10')

- Tag alder* (*Alnus serrulata*)

Small tree (up to 25')

- Witch-hazel (*Hamamelis virginiana*)
Red cedar (*Juniperus virginiana*)
Persimmon (*Diospyros virginiana*)
E. Redbud (*Cercis canadensis*)

Large tree (over 25')

- River birch* (*Betula nigra*)
Sycamore* (*Platanus occidentalis*)
Red maple* (*Acer rubrum*)
Tulip tree (*Linodendron tulipifera*)
Beech (*Fagus grandifolia*)
Red Mulberry (*Morus rubra* L.)
Sugar Maple (*Acer saccharum*)
Green ash (*Fraxinus pennsylvanica*)
Sweet Gum (*Liquidambar styraciflua*)
Black Gum (*Nyssa sylvatica*)

*Can tolerate hydric soil conditions; plants may be periodically or often inundated by water
