If you have an area in your garden with perennially moist soil, plants from this list will make excellent additions and stand a better chance of survival.

Devil's Walkingstick	<i>Aralia spinosa</i>	Moist	5-20 ft.	White bloom/ Purple stems	July-Aug
River Birch	<i>Betula nigra</i>	Moist to Wet	20-30 ft.	Papery bark	April
Buttonbush	<i>Cephalanthus occidentalis</i>	Moist to Wet	5-8 ft.	Round white blooms	June-July
Swamp Dogwood	<i>Cornus amomum</i>	Moist to Wet	6-10 ft.	Red stems	June-July
Inkberry	<i>Ilex glabra</i>	Moist	2-5 ft.	Evergreen	May-June
Winterberry	<i>Ilex verticillata</i>	Moist to Wet	3-5 ft.	Red berries	May-June
Virginia Sweetspire	<i>Itea virginica</i>	Moist	3-4 ft.	Clumps/White bloom	May
Spicebush	<i>Lindera benzoin</i>	Moist	10-15 ft.	Edible berries	April-May
Sycamore	<i>Plantanus occidentalis</i>	Moist to Wet	30-50 ft.	White scaly bark	May
Yellowroot	<i>Xanthorriza simplicissima</i>	Moist to Wet	1-2 ft.	Looks like parsley	April
