This Great Plains No-till Drill was purchased by the Hiwassee River Watershed Coalition, Inc. using public monies through a grant from the North Carolina Clean Water Management Trust Fund. The drill is available for use in the upper Hiwassee River watershed (preference will be given to those who rent the drill for use on land in Clay and Cherokee counties). The drill will be inspected after each use for damages. **The Lessee is responsible for the drill while it is in his/her possession and will be liable for any and all lost parts and/or repair costs.**

Other Requirements:

- Minimum of ¾ ton truck is needed to tow the drill
- Minimum of 60 hp (or 4-wheel drive) tractor is required for steeper slopes (weight is the issue); a smaller hp drive tractor can handle the drill on flat ground.
- Tractor must have hydraulic hook-ups in the rear.
- No sharp turns should be made with the drill; Lift drill with hydraulics before starting a turn to prevent warping discs
- Must be returned with drawbar

Other Requirements:

- Minimum of $\frac{3}{4}$ ton truck is needed to tow the drill.
- Minimum of 60 hp (or 4-wheel drive) tractor is required for steeper slopes (weight is the issue); a smaller hp drive tractor can handle the drill on flat ground.
- Tractor must have hydraulic hook-ups in the rear.
- No sharp turns should be made with the drill; Lift drill with hydraulics before starting a turn to prevent warping discs.
- Must be returned with drawbar
