

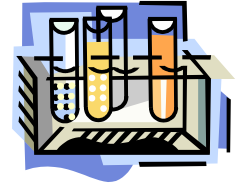
Ani'ama' – The Water People

HRWC's Volunteer Monitoring Program

Instructions

On the **3rd Saturday** of each month as close to 12:00 (noon) as possible:

- ◆ Take the air and water temperature
- ◆ Perform the dissolved oxygen test on site and record your results
- ◆ Collect your water samples
- ◆ Complete the data sheet as thoroughly as possible
- ◆ Fill out HRWC Volunteer Timesheet



Bring your wooden box with the six filled, plastic bottles and the baggie with the data sheet and volunteer timesheet directly to the appropriate drop-off location. If there is a long delay between the time you collect your sample and the time it is dropped off, please keep the sample bottles cold. The drop-off manager will record the refrigerator or cooler temperature and give you a set of empty plastic bottles for the next month's samples.

Someone will be at the drop-off location to help you and answer any questions you might have. Please complete your Volunteer Timesheet located with the data sheet in the plastic baggie and turn it in with your samples at the drop-off location each month.
