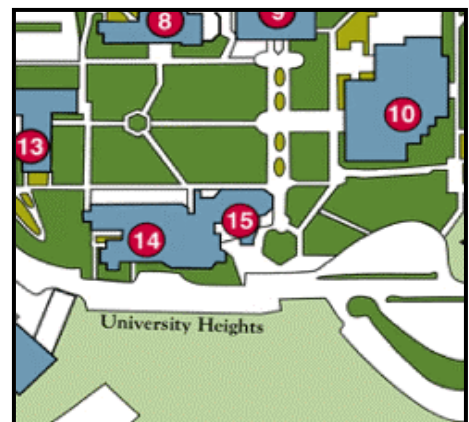

**Total Distance: 109 miles    Total Estimated Time: 2 hours 18 minutes**

1.	From the Peachtree Farm & Home Supply parking lot, <b>turn LEFT</b> onto NC-141. Follow NC-141 to the intersection with US 74 in Marble.	6.2 mi
2.	<b>Turn RIGHT</b> onto US-74 E/US-129 N/US-19 N. Continue to follow US-74 E past Andrews, Bryson City, Sylva, and Waynesville.	76.6 mi
4.	After you pass Lake Junaluska, take the exit ramp onto <b>I-40/ASHEVILLE</b> .	0.9 mi
5.	Merge onto I-40 East.	18.2 mi
6.	Continue on I-40E past the junction with I-26, following signs to Asheville.	0.5 mi
7.	Merge onto <b>I-240 via EXIT 46B on the LEFT</b> toward Asheville. Use the left lane. After about 3.0 miles, prepare to exit again using the left lane.	3.8 mi
8.	Take <b>EXIT 4A on the LEFT</b> toward UNC-A/WEAVERVILLE and merge onto US-70 W/US-19N/US-23 N. [Note: There is a different exit that goes to the sharp left; you want Exit 4A to the slight left.]	1.6 mi
9.	Take <b>EXIT 25 (NC-251)</b> toward the UNIVERSITY OF NC-ASHEVILLE.	0.2 mi
10.	Take the ramp on the right toward UNC ASHEVILLE and turn right onto BROADWAY ST.	<0.2 mi
11.	<b>At the second stoplight, turn SHARP LEFT</b> onto WEAVER BLVD.	0.5 mi
12.	At the roundabout, you should see the entrance to UNCA on the left. Make the <b>RIGHT turn out of the roundabout</b> into the college entrance.	0.1 mi
13.	<b>Turn LEFT</b> onto UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS and stay to the LEFT when you get to the top of the hill.	0.25 mi

You will pass parking lots on both sides. Just past the building on the right with the greenhouse (Robinson), you will see a sign for Rhoades Hall (number 14 pictured) where you will leave the samples. You will be across from the cafeteria. If you can't find a place to park that's close, pull up in the walkway to unload. It's a wide walkway with no curb.

Bring the samples into the Rhoades Hall building just inside the double glass doors. There you should find your replacement kits. **Take full kits out of coolers and stack next to the empty kits. Put empty kits into coolers and bring both the empty kits and coolers back to the Coalition office.**



Note: It is common for no one to be around the ground level when you make this exchange. Program staff members know to keep checking for our samples and will get them! If you need assistance, the EQI laboratory is upstairs; ask for Marilyn Westphal.

**Total Distance: 109 miles    Total Estimated Time: 2hrs 18min**

1.	Start out going WEST on UNIVERSITY HTS toward WEAVER BLVD.	0.1 miles
2.	Stay straight to go onto WEAVER BLVD.	0.5 miles
3.	<b>Turn SHARP RIGHT</b> onto BROADWAY ST/NC-1781. [BROADWAY ST/NC-1781 becomes NC-251.] Immediately begin looking for signs for US-19 South.	0.1 miles
4.	<b>Turn RIGHT to access US-19 South.</b> [There are signs there that make it look like you are getting on I-26, but these are just directing people back TO I-26 via US-19.]	2.3 miles
5.	<b>Merge onto I-240 W</b> on the RIGHT toward I-26 and I-40.	3.3 miles
6.	<b>Take EXIT 1A on the RIGHT</b> toward CANTON/KNOXVILLE and merge onto I-40 West.	18.2 miles
7.	<b>Take EXIT 27</b> toward CLYDE/WAYNESVILLE/MURPHY/MAGGIE VALLEY on the RIGHT and merge onto US-74 W/US-129 S/US-19 S.	78.3 miles
8.	At the first traffic light after passing through Andrews, turn LEFT onto NC-141. [There is a "Big D" Phillips 66 on the corner.]	6.2 miles
9.	Turn RIGHT into the parking lot of Peachtree Farm & Home Supply just before the Citgo station.	<0.1 miles

Because the Coalition is a §501(c)(3) organization, all donations are tax deductible. The applicable mileage rate for a volunteer is \$0.14/mile. **Please be sure to record your mileage** either on your monthly volunteer water sampling time sheet or tell us how many miles you traveled when bringing the replacement kits back the Coalition office.
